

Have you heard the news?



New Mexico Educational Assistance Foundation (NMEAF) now has federal approval to work with student specific data for New Mexico's FAFSA outreach. A special thank you to the New Mexico Higher Education Department (NMHED) for assisting us with acquiring the data permissions needed to make this happen, just in time for the new school year.

How does this help?

NMEAF can now provide *direct communications* to your students and families utilizing all their communications technologies, and call center personnel to contact students that have not started the FAFSA, or have errors on the form; free FAFSA assistance to help them complete.

Is this automatic?

Although many school districts have signed up, a signed service agreement is still required from your district. This is provided by NMEAF and does require a district superintendent signature.




Student Financial Aid Education Counselor Demo Course:






NEW LOOK AND FEEL OF FAFSA.GOV

- Single Sign-on Experience




SIGN AND SUBMIT IMPROVEMENTS

 - Parents and dependent students will be able to switch users in order to allow the other to sign.







