New Mexico Course Consortium



The New Mexico Course Consortium is a network of public districts and charters collaborating to support New Mexico's students, families, and schools by expanding access to learning opportunities through supplemental open enrollment.

The primary goal of the consortium is to assist all districts across New Mexico that want to expand unique, hard-to-staff, or credit recovery course opportunities to their students and families. The NMCC Network of Providers makes available virtual and/or hybrid courses to supplement local student course enrollment.

Consortium Highlights

- To date, 17 schools/districts and 245 students successfully participated.
- Thirteen percent of students were identified as dropouts or missing.
- Thirty-five students who took consortium courses graduated in spring 2022.
- New Mexico districts were supported in mitigating staffing shortages.
- Active member of the Virtual Learning Leadership Alliance.
